

These notes of past Passover services are provided as a reference to how we conduct the Passover. While we keep a basic service as practiced by many Church of God groups, an effort is made each year to emphasize a different aspect of the sacrifice of our Savior and its importance to us as His disciples.

Passover 1999

Last Passover in 20 century as man counts time.

1968 years since Jesus was crucified for our sins.

Six baptized participants last year. Three this year. Thousands keeping elsewhere.

(Similar to Passover of 2009 & 2016)

Gen 22:1-2 God tells Abraham to offer Isaac as a burnt offering. IF Abraham has sacrificed his son, who would have been responsible for his death? Abraham or God?

Who is RESPONSIBLE for the death of Jesus Christ? (Not what caused His death.)

There are several answers to that question. The one we usually talk about is that our sins made it necessary for Jesus as the Son of God, God in the flesh, to shed His blood for forgiveness. That is correct.

But who determined that blood had to be shed for the forgiveness of sins? Who determined that God would have to become flesh and blood in order to suffer and die for our sins? God the Father.

John 3:16 God so loved the world that He gave His only Son. The needs of the many outweigh the One.

Rom 8:31-34 Father did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all

Who is responsible for Jesus' death?

1. God the Father, His holy righteousness demanded it as part of His Plan of Salvation.

What is it like to send someone to their death? Military generals, presidents, prime ministers, & kings
